- H.R. 3641, To establish Pinnacles National Park in the State of California as a unit of the National Park System, and for other purposes. *"Pinnacles National Park Act"*
- **H.R. 4100**, To strengthen enforcement mechanisms to stop illegal, unreported, and unregulated fishing, to amend the Tuna Conventions Act of 1950 to implement the Antigua Convention, and for other purposes. *"Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing Enforcement Act of 2011"*
- **H.R. 4484**, To provide for the conveyance of a small parcel of National Forest System land in the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest in Utah to Brigham Young University, and for other purposes. *"Y Mountain Access Enhancement Act"*
- H.R. 4606, To authorize the issuance of right-of-way permits for natural gas pipelines in Glacier National Park, and for other purpose.
- **H.R. 5958**, To name the Jamaica Bay Wildlife Refuge Visitor Contact Station of the Jamaica Bay Wildlife Refuge unit of Gateway National Recreation Area in honor of James L. Buckley.
- H.R. 5987, To establish the Manhattan Project National Historical Park in Oak Ridge, Tennessee, Los Alamos, New Mexico, and Hanford, Washington, and for other purposes. *"Manhattan Project National Historical Park Act"*
