In title I, insert after section 105 the following new section 106 (and redesignate existing section 106 accordingly):

SEC. 106. CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION FOR DECISIONS TO IN CREASE ACCESS TO FOREST SERVICE LEVEL 3 ROADS.

4 A categorical exclusion is available to a Forest Super-5 visor whenever the Forest Supervisor, with respect to any Forest Service Level 3 road in existence as of the date 6 7 of the enactment of this Act within the unit of the National Forest System administered by the Forest Super-8 9 visor, is making a decision whether or not to increase access on the Forest Service road by authorizing additional 10 11 modes of transportation on the road, such as the use of off-road vehicles and snowmobiles. 12
