

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1231**  
**OFFERED BY MR. PALLONE OF NEW JERSEY**

Page 2, strike line 8 and all that follows through page 3, line 16, and insert the following:

1           “(4) PROHIBITION OF OIL AND GAS LEASING IN  
2           CERTAIN AREAS OF THE OUTER CONTINENTAL  
3           SHELF.—

4                   “(A) IN GENERAL.—No oil and gas leasing  
5           program under this section may make available  
6           for preleasing, leasing, and related activities  
7           any area of the outer Continental Shelf lo-  
8           cated—

9                           “(i) in any Marine National Monu-  
10                           ment or national marine sanctuary; or

11                           “(ii) in the New York/New Jersey  
12                           Bight.

13                   “(B) EFFECT.—Nothing in this paragraph  
14           affects any rights under leases issued under  
15           this Act before the date of enactment of this  
16           paragraph.

17           “(5) DESIGNATION OF NEW JERSEY/NEW YORK  
18           CLEAN OCEAN ZONE.—Each oil and gas leasing pro-  
19           gram under this section shall designate and refer to

1 the New York/New Jersey Bight as the ‘New Jersey/  
2 New York Clean Ocean Zone’.

3 “(6) NEW YORK/NEW JERSEY BIGHT DE-  
4 FINED.—In this paragraph the term ‘New York/New  
5 Jersey Bight’ means the geographic area within the  
6 Atlantic Ocean generally known by that name and  
7 located within the boundaries described more par-  
8 ticularly as follows: Beginning at a point at the  
9 southern tip of Cape May, New Jersey, and run-  
10 ning—

11 “(A) northerly along the mean high water  
12 mark of the coast of New Jersey to the north-  
13 ern tip of Sandy Hook, New Jersey, then

14 “(B) northeasterly along the transect of  
15 the northern tip of Sandy Hook and the west-  
16 ern tip of Long Island, New York, then

17 “(C) easterly along the mean high water  
18 mark of the south shore of Long Island to the  
19 eastern tip of Long Island, New York, then

20 “(D) southerly to the eastern bank of  
21 Block Canyon to the 1,000 fathom line of the  
22 Continental Shelf, then

23 “(E) southwesterly along the 1,000 fathom  
24 line to the western bank of Baltimore Canyon,  
25 and then

1                   “(F) northwesterly to the point of begin-  
2                   ning at the southern tip of Cape May, New Jer-  
3                   sey.”.
