Subject: Full Committee Markup Notice – **REVISED** (correcting bill number)

On **Thursday, September 18, 2014, in 1324 Longworth House Office Building**, the Committee on Natural Resources will hold a markup at 11:00 a.m. or after the conclusion of the Joint Session of Congress, whichever occurs later, on the following bills:

- **HR 69 (Bordallo),** To strengthen enforcement mechanisms to stop illegal, unreported, and unregulated fishing, to amend the Tuna Conventions Act of 1950 to implement the Antigua Convention, and for other purposes. *(Illegal, Unreported, and Unregulated Fishing Enforcement Act of 2013)*
- **HR 706** (**Cicilline**), To establish the Blackstone River Valley National Historical Park, to dedicate the Park to John H. Chafee, and for other purposes. (*Blackstone River Valley National Historical Park Establishment Act*)
- **HR 712 (Frelinghuysen),** To extend the authorization of the Highlands Conservation Act through fiscal year 2024.
- **HR 1363 (Labrador),** To promote timely exploration for geothermal resources under existing geothermal leases, and for other purposes. *(Exploring for Geothermal Energy on Federal Lands Act)*
- **HR 1839 (Tipton),** To designate certain Federal land in the San Juan National Forest in the State of Colorado as wilderness, and for other purposes. (*Hermosa Creek Watershed Protection Act of 2013*)

- HR 3226 (Rice), To remove from the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System certain properties in South Carolina.
- HR 3227 (Rice), To remove from the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System certain properties in South Carolina.
- **HR 3326 (Huffman),** To provide for an exchange of land between the United States and the Trinity Public Utilities District of Trinity County, California, involving a parcel of National Forest System land in Shasta-Trinity National Forest. (*Trinity County Land Exchange Act of 2013*)

- HR 3608 (Nolan), To amend the Act of October 19, 1973, concerning taxable income to members of the Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa Indians. (*Grand Portage Band Per Capita Adjustment Act*)
- **HR 3980** (**McClintock**), To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to coordinate Federal and State permitting processes related to the construction of new surface water storage projects on lands under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Agriculture and to designate the Bureau of Reclamation as the lead agency for permit processing, and for other purposes. (*Water Supply Permitting Coordination Act*)
- **HR 3981 (Hastings of Washington),** To direct the Secretary of the Interior to allow for prepayment of repayment contracts between the United States and water users, to provide surface water storage enhancement, and for other purposes. (Accelerated Revenue, Repayment, and Surface Water Storage Enhancement Act)
- HR 4166 (Thompson of California), To transfer recreational management authority for Lake Berryessa in the State of California from the Bureau of Reclamation to the Bureau of Land Management, and for other purposes. (*Lake Berryessa Recreation Enhancement Act of 2014*)
- **HR 4534 (Cramer),** To amend the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act to require background checks before foster care placements are ordered in tribal court proceedings, and for other purposes. (*Native American Children's Safety Act*)
- **HR 4846 (Polis),** To adjust the boundary of the Arapaho National Forest, Colorado, and for other purposes. (*Arapaho National Forest Boundary Adjustment Act of 2014*)
- **HR 5003** (**Gingrey**), To adjust the boundary of the Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park to include the Wallis House and Harriston Hill, and for other purposes. (*Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park Boundary Adjustment Act of 2014*)
- **HR 5040** (**Labrador**), To require the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal land to Idaho County in the State of Idaho, and for other purposes. (*Idaho County Shooting Range Land Conveyance Act*)
- **HR 5049 (Simpson),** To exchange trust and fee land to resolve land disputes created by the realignment of the Blackfoot River along the boundary of the Fort Hall Indian Reservation, and for other purposes. (*Blackfoot River Land Exchange Act of 2014*)
- HR 5050 (Simpson), To repeal the Act of May 31, 1918, and for other purposes. (*May 31, 1918 Act Repeal Act*)
- HR 5139 (Clawson), To correct the boundaries of the John H. Chafee Coastal Barrier Resources System Unit P16.
- **HR 5162** (Goodlatte), To amend the Act entitled "An Act to allow a certain parcel of land in Rockingham County, Virginia, to be used for a child care center" to remove the use restriction, and for other purposes.
- **HR 5167** (**Young of Alaska**), To direct the Administrator of General Services, on behalf of the Secretary of the Interior, to convey certain Federal property located in the National Petroleum Reserve in Alaska to the Olgoonik Corporation, an Alaska Native Corporation established under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.
- HR 5412 (Hastings of Washington), To facilitate and streamline the Bureau of Reclamation process for creating or expanding surface water storage under Reclamation law. (*Bureau of Reclamation Surface Water Storage Streamlining Act*)

• **HR 5476**, (**Hastings of Washington**), To modify the Forest Service Recreation Residence Program as the program applies to units of the National Forest System derived from the public domain by implementing a simple, equitable, and predictable procedure for determining cabin user fees, and for other purposes. (*Cabin Fee Act of 2014*)

- **S 363 (Wyden),** A bill to expand geothermal production, and for other purposes. (*Geothermal Production Expansion Act of 2013*)
- S 609 (Udall of New Mexico), A bill to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain Federal land in San Juan County, New Mexico, and for other purposes. (San Juan County Federal Land Conveyance Act)
