**Amendment to the Amendment
In the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 6510
Offered by Mr. Graves of Louisiana**

On Page 2, after line 16, insert:

“(4) Limitation—No funds shall be made available to the Fund under this section until the Secretary certifies to Congress that the offshore areas generating revenue to the Fund are in a comparable or improved ecological, resilience, and sustainable condition as compared to the areas determined to receive funding under subsection (e) of this Act.”

On page 2, after line 16, insert, “(4) To the extent that revenues payable to the National Park Service from the collection of recreation fees increases each fiscal year, the amount deposited in the Fund and in subsection (2) shall be reduced on a pro rata basis.”.

On Page 3, Strike lines 12-14 and replace with:

“(3) Income Generated from Investment.—Any income on such investments of the Fund shall be made available for the maintenance of any federal lands not otherwise described in Subsection (e) of this Act.”

On Page 5, Strike lines 4-5, insert the following:

“(3) for Department of Interior salaries, bonuses, expenses, or any administrative costs of carrying out this Act.”

On Page 2, after line 16, insert:

“(4) Limitation—No funds under this section may be made available to the Fund until the Secretary certifies to Congress that the federal lands and waters on which oil, gas, coal, or alternative or renewable energy is developed are mitigated to address such impacts of deriving such funds.”.

“less any amounts received in a Fiscal Year, pursuant to Section 2(i), in that Fiscal Year”

On page 2, line 11 after “,” insert, “the distribution of a portion of the receipts from the leasing of mineral resources of the outer continental shelf adjacent to State lands, as provided under section 8(g) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act (43 U.S.C. 1332)”.”

On page 5, line 3, after line 5, insert the following:

“(3) For the purposes of addressing the priority deferred maintenance projects submitted in subsection (h) in states that the governor or legislatures have opposed such production.”.

On page 5, line 4, redesignate subparagraph (3) as (4).

Amendment #12

In the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 6510

On Page 3, lines 15 through 16, strike subsection (e) and insert the following:

“(e) Use of Funds—Amounts allocated from the Fund shall be prioritized on a pro rata basis to support projects in States from which revenues in the Fund were originally derived. Amounts in the Fund shall be used as follows:”.

On Page 5, strike lines 6 through 13 and insert:

“(h) Submission to Congress—The Secretary of Interior shall submit to the Committee on Appropriations and Energy and Natural Resources of the Senate and to the Committees on Appropriations and Natural Resources in the House of Representatives, with the annual budget submission of the President—

(1) A list of projects for which the amounts in the Fund are allocated under this section, prioritized on a pro rata basis to support projects in States from which revenues in the Fund were originally derived, including a description of each such project.

(i) For the purposes of (1) offshore production revenues shall be considered to be generated in a state if the geographic center of the lease tract is located within the area formed by the extension of the state’s seaward lateral boundaries, calculated using the connections established to delineate international boundaries under the Law of the sea.”.

On Page 2, after line 16, insert:

“(4) Limitation—No funds shall be made available to the Fund under this section until the President certifies to Congress that full recovery has been made from Hurricane Florence and the 2018 wildfire season.”

On page 2, line 2, strike “Federal law.”, and insert “Federal law only when revenues from oil, gas, coal, or alternative or renewable energy development on Federal land and water is in excess of the baseline 10-year projections of the Congressional Budget Office for each fiscal year.”.

Amendment #16

On page 3, line 17, strike subparagraph (1) and insert the following:

“(1) 80 percent of amounts in the Fund shall be allocated to assist the states of Utah, Wyoming, Montana, Oregon, Colorado, and Idaho to support the implementation of State Wildlife Actions Plans that protects, restores, and improves greater sage-grouse habitat.”.

Amendment # 19

On page 6, line 20, insert the following:

“(j) RECOGNITION OF REVENUES

(1) IN GENERAL.—projects funded by the Fund shall require a sign to specify that the project is funded from energy production on Federal land and waters.”

On page 1, strike line 14 through page 2 line 2 and insert, “payments deposited in the Treasury of the State within the boundaries of which the leased Federal land is located or the deposits were derived from oil and gas development.”.
