

Mission Statement

Our paramount mission is to contribute to the security and stability of the United States. To that end, we shall propose and be advocates for Immigration laws and policies that we believe serve those national interests, and we will oppose those that do not.

NAFBPO devotes itself to the study of the Immigration Act and its elected representatives about the issues of immigration. What has worked in the past, what has not, and why.

Comment: NAFBPO is a nonpartisan, nonpolitical organization. We do not endorse candidates or parties; we do not discuss policies and positions. We are not affiliated with any other organization; we are beholden to no one. Thus, we are entirely free to say what we believe.

Who We Are

NAFBPO's (that is, decision-making) membership consists of former officers of the U.S. Border Patrol. Many of our Senior members retired from supervisory or management positions. There are many Port Sector Chiefs and Deputies in our group and several former Chiefs of the Border Patrol.

Our experience base is not limited to those who served in the organization's name. Many of our members spent their careers in the Border Patrol but many were in other agencies of the Border Patrol's old parent, INS. Thus, we number many former directors and other high-level INS personnel in our membership.

Furthermore, membership is open, not just to officers who served in the Border Patrol, but to anyone who was a sworn officer of the old INS regardless of where he began his career. Our collective organizational experience covers all facets of Immigration operations.

Our recollections go back to the early 1950s, in some cases even predating the McCarran-Walters Act.

There is no other organization in the United States that has our first-hand knowledge of the subject of immigration.
